Note: The 8 steps above show how the SAIs will be supported to strengthen their capacity and all the stages involved up to having a signed agreement with providers of support. The 8 steps are hinged on INTOSAI best practices and ensures that capacity strengthening support is SAI led and based on the SAIs strategy. We have developed a way of grouping the SAIs based on needs assessment and maturity of strategic planning as we believe that Identifying SAI needs and utilising quality SAI strategic plan are crucial to providing quality sustainable support and attaining longterm SAI ownership of support.
