
IDC's Impact Information

The INTOSAI-Donor Cooperation (IDC) aims to enhance the capacity of Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) in developing countries, through...

- nnovative matchmaking services between Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) and donors and development partners.
- D evelopment funding brokerage to enhance government accountability across the globe.
- oordinated, SAI-lead, scaled-up support, delivered at country level for SAIs in developing countries

To date, **663** projects in **217** locations with a total spend of 1,075,814,195 USD have been recorded in the SAI Capacity Development Database.

Bilateral, SAI-led support has been provided to the strategic plans of nine SAIs in fragile contexts via the Accelerated Peer-Support Partnership or PAP-APP initiative.

The Global SAI Survey and the resulting Global SAI Stocktaking Report have helped provide 10 years of knowledge-based support to SAIs around the world.

The Global Call for Proposals has generated 60 matches for funding to SAIs.

PFAC

When the INTOSAI grant for priority pandemic-related IT and Health and Safety support 67,766 closed at the end of 2021, 54 proposals had been approved with each awarded €11,429 for

a total award of €617,166.





FISP

2021: Since the General Court of Audit of Saudi Arabia (GCA) created the FISP fund, **28 SAIs** have received grants already, and 15 more have been accepted to be recipients soon.

BUSS

The Brokering Upscaled SAI Support initiative which matches donors and funding with SAI needs - also known as the BUSS – launched to eight SAIs in the CREFIAF region in 2022 and will roll out to OLACEFS in August 2023. https://intosaidonor.

GSAI

The Global SAI Accountability Initiative (GSAI) launched in 2023 is already lining up direct support in resources, expertise and financial grants to 8 SAIs in fragile contexts.
